Dear Potential Volunteer,

We are glad to learn that you may be interested in volunteering at the Gingerbread House Bossier/Caddo Children's Advocacy Center. Our primary purpose is to interview children when there is an allegation that they have been the victim of sexual or severe physical abuse. Each interview is recorded with an unobtrusive camera to preserve the account as evidence. Law enforcement detectives and child protection investigators monitor the interview from a television in the next room and can ask the interviewer questions through an earpiece. The purpose of this approach is to help substantiate or disclaim the allegations of abuse as well as reduce the number of times a child must tell his/her account. We work with agencies such as the D.A.'s office, Office of Community Services (Child Protection), law enforcement and mental/medical professionals to provide the best quality of care possible to the children. Each child is given a new toy and stuffed animal to take with them when they leave. Follow-up counseling services are offered at the Gingerbread House by licensed professional counselors.

Our funding comes from grants as well as from generous individuals and organizations. All of our services are provided free of charge. The number of children we serve is continually rising, over 500 per year. With this reality, volunteers are a necessary part of the functioning of the Gingerbread House. Volunteers assist with a variety of tasks, based on their skills and their area of interest and the needs of the Center. These tasks may include general administrative duties, cleaning, yard work, fundraisers, and helping monitor children in the waiting area. For individual volunteer opportunities, please complete the enclosed form. Please make note on the form what days and hours you expect to be available to assist us. For anyone 18 years and older, we are required to run a background check which usually takes about a month. After the screening process, we contact volunteers as needed. Please feel free to follow-up with us to check the status of your form.
